If you believe an item does not apply to your cat or that it is not related to your cat's heart disease, then circle 0 (Not at All) and go on to the next item. If the question does apply to your cat, then circle the number corresponding to how much it has negatively impacted your cat's comfort or sociability. Remember to consider THE LAST 7 DAYS ONLY.
